STATIONS OF THE CROSS: The Church will be open every day during Lent for your private Stations of the Cross. There are Stations of the Cross booklets on the lectern the back of the church for your use. We ask that you leave them in the church after using them.

NOTE FROM FR. JOHN: The mission of the Church has always been universal and global. Each local community of faith, while serving the needs of its members, is called to respond beyond its own community to the needs of others. As the executive director of Catholic Charities of the Rio Grande Valley on the U.S./Mexican border since 2004, Sr. Normal Pimentel, a member of the Missionaries of Jesus, sees up to 800 migrants everyday entering her center. This is often their first stop after being released from U. S. Customs and Border Protection. Sister and her staff help them organize the rest of their journey to their final destinations and provide them with new clothes, hot meals, and showers. As of last summer, more than 150,000 migrants have passed through the center.

In Thanksgiving for our 125 years of faith-oriented service to our surrounding communities, we make a \$25,000 gift to Catholic Charities of the Rio Grande Valley.
