Families have been helped by SHORE into clean, safe, apartments with stable residency; permitting improved school placement and employment searching. Families have been helped in Yonkers, Ardsley, White Plains, and Sleepy Hollow by SHORE. Our parishioner, Pierre Poux, has been honored in the past by Westchester County for his work on behalf of SHORE.
