NOTE FROM FR. JOHN: Dear Parishioners, as promised, I want to provide a financial accounting of our 125th anniversary activities. Your generosity was outstanding. All 125th anniversary projects (monthly second collections, journal, dinner, picnic, and ornaments) brought in \$141,766.61. Our expenses (subsidized events, printing, mailing, parish dinner, and Cardinal's reception) were \$57,801.58. The net was \$83,964.93. This money was held in a segregated parish account, separated from general parish funds. Because of your generosity in our weekly Sunday collection for parish needs, we are in the enviable position of being able to share our blessings with local and national organizations endeavoring to assist men, women, and children in genuine need. In the next four bulletins I will profile those organizations. All four are federally recognized tax-exempt 501(C) (3) charitable agencies. Generosity is the overflowing of love into the lives of others. I cannot think of a better way for our parish to express its gratitude for 125 years than to extend our blessings to others. And, as promised, we will suspend our monthly second collection for the parish!!!
