CARDINAL'S STEWARDSHIP APPEAL 2019 has begun. Some of you have already received a letter from the Cardinal asking for your support. In the past two years we have exceeded the goal set by the Archdiocese. This year our goal is **\$48,500**, an increase of \$5000 over last year. Please be as generous as your financial means will allow. We will be giving periodic updates in our bulletin on the amount our parish has raised.

As mentioned in a previous bulletin, our parish has been enrolled by the diocese in the **Renew and Rebuild Campaign**. While we have been informed that we will not be required to conduct a campaign, we will be required to remit to the diocese 26% of what our campaign goal would have been. We are still waiting for the diocese to provide the actual figure. As soon as I know the figure, I will negotiate with the diocese regarding the manner of payment. It is my intention to dispose of this obligation as quickly as possible with the least amount of disruption to our regular parish cycle of events and second collections. Let's see how successful I will be.
