LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE: During the season of Lent, the Church urges the faithful to reflect a spirit of penance in their daily lives through performing acts of faith and abstinence.

FASTING requires that only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day. There is no eating between meals. Fasting obliges to all those 18-59.

ABSTINENCE prohibits individuals from eating meat on a particular day. Abstinence obliges to all those 14 and continues throughout their lives.

ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY ARE DAYS OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE. FRIDAYS N LENT ARE DAYS OF ABSTINENCE.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: The Church will be open every day during Lent for your private Stations of the Cross.
